

SYCAMORE MUSIC BOOSTERS
2023 CONTINUING COLLEGE MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP
FOR THOSE WHO PARTICIPATE IN MUSIC AT A COLLEGE LEVEL

The Sycamore Music Boosters are accepting applications from Sycamore High School graduates who are currently participating in music in college, such as choir, orchestra, marching band but not majoring in music. The Boosters may award one or several scholarships, depending on the applications and the status of the scholarship fund. The single scholarship amount is \$1000. This is a competitive scholarship and the recipient or recipients will be determined based on the overall quality of the applications submitted.

In order to qualify for this scholarship, students must be an undergraduate college sophomore, junior, or senior during the 2023-2024 academic year and must be participating in a music activity, such as jazz band, marching band, choir, orchestra, etc. and have a G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher.

Application Deadline: July 7, 2023

To apply students must include the following in the application packet:

1. A cover letter with current contact information including telephone numbers, address and email address.
2. Verification that the student is formally enrolled in college and verifying the student's status as a sophomore, junior, or senior during the 2023-2024 academic year. It should also include proof of participation in music activity such as a letter or performance information.

3. A **current, official** and **complete** college transcript. This should be sent by the college/university and be officially sealed.
4. A typed, detailed summary/list of the student's college music involvement including ensembles, solos, recitals, accomplishments and awards.
5. A recent photo. (May be informal.)

Late and incomplete applications will not be considered.

Please Note: Students can be awarded a scholarship a maximum of two times if they meet the criteria.
